Re: Red Flag Warnings & District Burn Bans

Recently we were asked by dispatch to notify them when there is a red flag warning in zones 214, 216, or both.

If a red flag warning has been declared in any area of Park County the Sheriff will institute a burn ban for the entire county/ all districts.

When we have identified that there is a red flag warning in Park County we must call dispatch over their landline and notify them of when the red flag warning will begin. If this information can be given the day before or early in the morning on the day of the warning that is preferred.

We will not come out of the ban until our agency has notified dispatch that we would like to have the burn ban restrictions removed.

It is the responsibility of all shift officers to make sure this obligation has been met and PCFD will provide this service to the dispatchers until dispatch is able to correct some software issues that they are currently experiencing.
